

PIN HAD SLANT TO NORTH. IT IS BELIEVED THAT PIN WAS ORIGINALLY SLANTED NORTH OVER THE CENTER OF STONE AND HAS SINCE BEEN DRIVEN DOWN. HITCH PIN WAS OVER IRON PIN AND 0.22' SOUTH OF CENTER OF STONE.
