Petition to <sup>1</sup> Reconstruction by deepening and widening of the Bradford-Lindsay Ditch in Sections 17, 16 and 9 of Allen Township.

To the Board of County Commissioners, Ottawa County, Ohio:  
Commissioners, Engineer.

The undersigned hereby petition your honorable body to <sup>1</sup> Reconstruct by Deepening and widening of the Bradford-Lindsay Ditch in Sections 17, 16 and 9 of Allen Twp. on the course hereinafter set forth.

The construction of the improvement is necessary, and will be conducive to the public welfare.

The following is the course and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit:

Commencing at a concrete arch culvert under the New York Central Railroad said culvert being located approximately 300 feet west of the property line between lands owned by Lawrence & Elaine Gruetter and Edna Reeder in the south one-half of Section 17 in Allen Township. Thence east along the north side of said NEW YORK CENTRAL Railroad approximately 300 feet to said property line; thence northerly and easterly following the course of said ditch to the Reiman Road #53; thence north along the west side of said road #53 to where the ditch crosses Road #53; thence in a northeasterly direction crossing the Trownridge Rd #67 and continuing in a northeasterly direction to the outlet in the north branch of Turtle Creek and there to terminate. Being a distance of approximately two (2) miles. Also a lateral to said ditch commencing at the New York Central Railroad on the west side of the Reiman Road #53 and running north along the west side of said Rd #53 to the above described ditch. A Distance of approximately .40 of a mile. Total length of above described main ditch and lateral being approximately 2.40 Miles.

The following is the nature of the work petitioned for: Reconstruction by deepening and widening.

 P. M., at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of said County be and  
 the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for the first hearing on the petition; and

Resolved, That notice of said view and hearing be given, as required by law.
