*Petition to*¹ clean or reconstruct all drainage structures or waterways necessary to alleviate flooding for areas draining into both the Dehring Ditch and Benton-Carroll Road Ditch in various sections of Benton and Carroll Townships.

To the Board of County Commissioners, Ottawa **County, Ohio:**

The undersigned hereby petition your honorable body *to*¹ initiate the process of cleaning or reconstructing all drainage structures or waterways necessary to alleviate flooding for areas draining into both the Dehring Ditch and Benton-Carroll Road Ditch in various sections of Benton and Carroll Townships.

On the course hereinafter set forth.

The construction of the improvement is necessary, will benefit the petitioner(s), and will be conducive to the public welfare.

The following is the course and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit:

Commencing at a point located near the division line of the SW and NW ¼ Post of Section 25, T7N-R14E of Benton Township, thence proceeding in a northeasterly direction along the existing centerline of the Dehring Ditch before proceeding north along Benton-Carroll Road (CR#23) to the point of intersection with the Toussaint Creek located in Section 13, T7N-R14E of Benton Township, or to an adequate outlet.

This petition shall also address drainage issues in the Benton-Carroll Roadside Ditch commencing at the intersection of the Norfolk Southern Pennsylvania Lines Railroad and the Benton-Carroll Roadside Ditch, located in Section 36, T7N-R14E of Benton Township, thence proceeding northerly along the existing centerline of the Benton-Carroll Roadside Ditch until termination at the intersection with the Dehring Ditch in Section 24, T7N-R14E of Benton Township, or to an adequate outlet. Petition shall also provide consideration of all contributing channels, structures, and/or waterways that may need some form of construction/reconstruction necessary to properly drain the watershed areas being described.

All costs of engineering, construction, and future maintenance will be assessed to the benefiting parcels of land, except under Section 6131.31 of the Revised Code.

The following is the nature of the work petitioned for: Petitioners request to have whatever work done that is necessary to provide positive drainage for the above described areas. Said work shall include, but not be limited to, cleaning existing waterways, creating new waterways, cleaning or fixing existing storm sewers and cross-over pipes, or installing new storm and cross-over pipes.
