Ditch starts at Third Street in Rocky Ridge east of SR 590 and flows north crossing the Conrail RR, True Road and stops at a point short of Toussaint Creek. This does create some issue, maintenance work is generally done farther downstream from the original project plan. This project also include a branch ditch along the north side of True Road. This branch on the south side of True Road starts just west of Rocky Ridge Road and outlets into the Krempke DitchFrom Third Street to the RR is very narrow with steep banks. The farm operator consistantly farms up to and over the edge with frequent herbicide damage. The low flow 24" RCP under the RR is 3/4 full and RR stone constantly rolls into the ditch. The pipe under Third Street is rusted and the village of Rocky Ridge has contacted the County Enguineer for guidance but the pipe is still not corrected. North of the RR has better grade. Immediately north of True Rd is a house lot with a culvert right after a curve. The landowner has installed more rip rap by his culvert and this should help the flow through this area. Brush spray in 2019.
