*Petition to* Reconstruct by deepening and possible widening The North Branch of Turtle Creek

To the Board of County Commissioners,

Ottawa County, Ohio:

*The undersigned hereby petition your honorable body to* Reconstruct by deepening and possible widening The North Branch of Turtle Creek

*on the course hereinafter set forth.*

*The construction of the improvement is necessary, and will be conducive to the public welfare.*

*The following is the course and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit:*

*Commencing* at the Billman Rd. #54 at the west line of Section 8, T7N, R13E, in Allen Township; thence easterly through Section 8 and 9 to the old interurban railroad right-of-way on the north and south half-section line of Section 9 in Allen Township and there to terminate.

Said proposed improvement covers a total distance of approximately 1.6 miles.
