This ditch needs extensive work and is practiaclly non existant as a functioning channel. This is a prime candidate to see if it should be abandoned as a maintenance project. Although this ditch could be improved			

it would be of benefit to pursue a new project through the legal process. The Village of Genoa has some storm drainage that outlets into this project. This may be the time to either do a six year review or see about abandoning
