Wood SWCD Section 1515.18 ORC Project Policy

Wood SWCD will recommend voluntary group cooperation to solve drainage problems in the county. If there is a lack of cooperation, a landowner may petition the District under section 1515.18 of the Ohio Revised Code (commonly known as Senate Bill 160) for drainage relief. Wood SWCD will charge a deposit to the landowner requesting the project.

Deposits will not be charged for Cooperative Group projects.

A deposit of \$500, plus the sum of two dollars for each parcel of land in excess of two hundred parcels averred in the petition to be benefited will be charged to the individual(s) that file the petition with the Wood SWCD. This deposit is used to cover costs of legal notices and mailings (postage, letterhead, envelopes, labels, etc.). Owners of land where construction will occur must be notified by certified mail and all other landowners by first class mail.

If the project is dismissed or withdrawn before the viewing or legal hearing, unused money after legal notice expenses and mailing costs will be returned to the person who paid the deposit. If the project is dismissed or withdrawn at any point after the legal hearing, the entire deposit shall be forfeited to the Wood SWCD. When the project is completed, the mailing cost will be assessed to all parcels in the project and the person(s) who paid the deposit will be reimbursed in full for the deposit.

The board of supervisors has the authority to turn down a Section 1515.18 ORC project if workload is a factor. This policy is in effect for single or joint county projects or Section 1515.18 ORC projects.

Items to Consider for the Objectors Hearing

1. Procedure

- a. Landowners were to Object to the assessment...not the project.
- b. A decision needs to be made on every Objection. This can be done at the Hearing, or the commissioners can adjourn until another date.
- 2. An official decision needs to be made on charging or not charging interest and a repayment period. Will bonds or notes be issued? What is the length of repayment?
- 3. The combining of contiguous parcels:
 - a. This item is where a high number of objections came from. ORC states:

1515.211

In no case shall an assessment be less than twenty-five dollars for each parcel of land, except in the case of a multi-parcel lot, in which case the board may charge a minimum of twenty-five dollars with respect to all of the parcels comprising the multi-parcel lot.

(B) As used in this section, "multi-parcel lot" means a site on which a dwelling is located and that comprises two or more contiguous parcels of land.

4. Incorrect acreage

- a. Another high objection number. Acreage has been corrected for most parcels (mostly Wood County)
- 5. Several objections are argued that the properties agricultural sub surface drainage (tile) goes to another watershed. Our process did not address anything but surface water.
- 6. One of our biggest issues in getting properties correct has been conflicting, lost, or forgotten information. We have tried our best, but something always pops up. An example is below:
 - a. We have a parcel in Wood County (Rodney Clark) that is in conflicting watersheds. We included them in the Toussaint based on the map for the Old Original Toussaint Petition (#2180). Now we see via the assessment roles that they are out. Surface water shows that it is partially in. Another project, the Maumee Watershed Conservancy District, has part of the acreage included for assessment, but the whole property mapped into the MWCD.
