Ditch starts as a shallow surface ditch on the east side of SR 19 and flows south on east side of SR 19 then east along a property line then back north to a drop structure which outlets into the open channel. It then flows east to Muddy Creek east of Woodrick Road. The shallow surface ditch section near the upper reach is gradually being farmed shut. At the current rate drainage will definitely be impacted. This will mostly impact the offending landowner. The reach east of Woodrick is backwater influenced with extended periods of standing water. The banks are steeper from erosion and soft. Sediment accumulates in this section. The landowner farms to the edge and aggravates the condition with herbicide damage and furrows. It is a constant fight with this landowner to maintain the ditch in this section. Most of the problems with this ditch is a direct result of poor farming practices and general lack of respect.
